Missouri Recycling Association to Hold Annual Awards Luncheon

The Missouri Recycling Association (MORA) will be holding its annual award luncheon on September 12 in Independence, Missouri as part of its annual conference. A total of 7 award winners will be recognized with the Missouri Recycling Association's Achievement Awards.

Tim Smith will receive the Lifetime Achievement award for his dedication to recycling. He served as Solid Waste District O (now OHRD) Chair from 2000 until his retirement in 2017. Under his leadership, the District grant program ensured access to recycling for citizens of all 5 counties and made the City of Springfield's Household Chemical Collection Center available at no cost to everyone. From 2000-2012 he served as the chair of the state Solid Waste Advisory Board (SWAB). Twice during his tenure, legislation affecting the governance of the districts was created and passed. Tim took a leadership role each time, ensuring the integrity of the Solid Waste Management Program and the continued relevance of the districts.

Since 1992 the Missouri Recycling Association has sought to lead Missouri toward environmental sustainability through waste reduction and recycling. Each year MORA recognizes companies, programs and individuals who have displayed dedication to this goal.
