







Q3. Do you or other members of your household currently do any of the following to reduce the amount of trash you throw away?



avaliable.


Cooper County 32.6% recycling more frequently – Why? 64.4% are using a drop-off.

by percentage of respondents (without "not provided")



Q11. If you recycle curbside, have you ever put something in the bin that you are not sure is accepted?





Q13. Have you seen or read any information concerning the impact of food waste in the last year? by percentage of respondents






Q19. How well do you think your community performs in terms of its commitment to recycling? by percentage of respondents
