2. Be sure to include in the letter:
  - Your name and affiliation with the Missouri Sheltered Workshop you represent
  - The services provided by the Missouri Sheltered Workshop
  - The geographic area served by the Missouri Sheltered Workshop
  - Your contact information including mailing and email address.

**Submissions must be received on or before 5:00 p.m., Friday, July 12, 2019.**

You will receive confirmation via email that your letter and support documentation has been received.
